Some notes on the pictures as provided by the modelers:

Jim Davis's B-17 401 BS of the 91st Bomb Group.

Jerry Richardson's P-51D was flown by L. Avril Roberson of the 37th Fighter Group, the Yoxford Boys. Jerry used Eagle Cal decals, Barracuda resin wheels and Radu seat belts.

Ricardo Macias's F-15A was from "ADTAC." His P-C was a WIP as it was missing the wind screen.

Arthur Berwick's Abrams was a Tusk II version. The T26E4 was the pilot model or the number 1 unit. The MBT 70 was a joint American/German effort. The P-204(f) was an armored scout vehicle circa WW II. The 54th Foot Infantry Regiment figure was circa 1812-1815 and the Napoleonic figures from Historex included a Grenadier a Drummer, a Fusilier and a Voltigeur of the Infanterie De Lignre.
