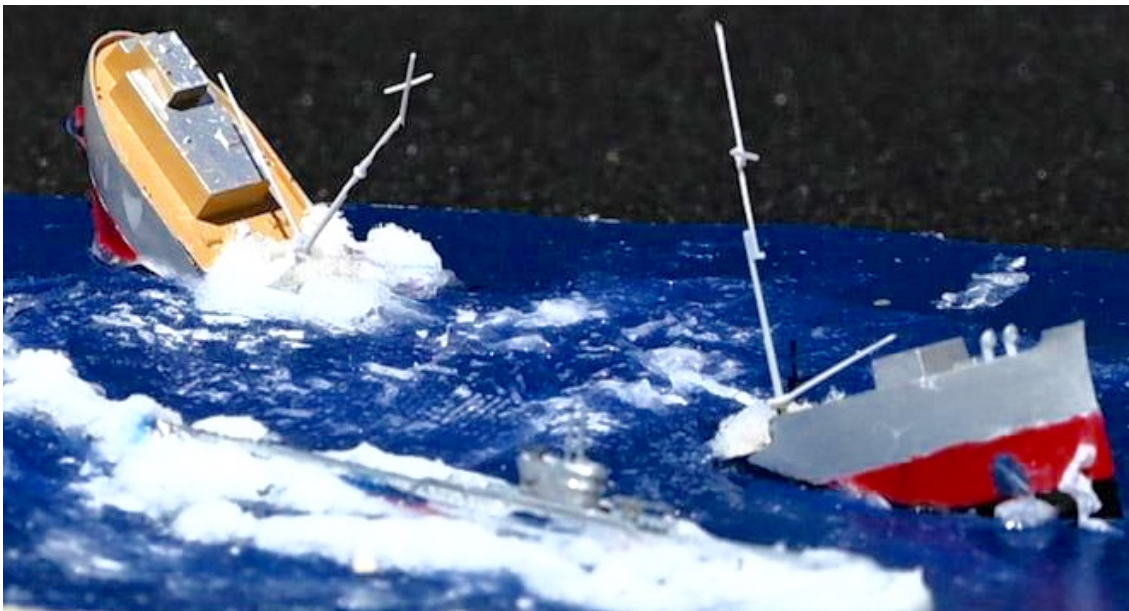

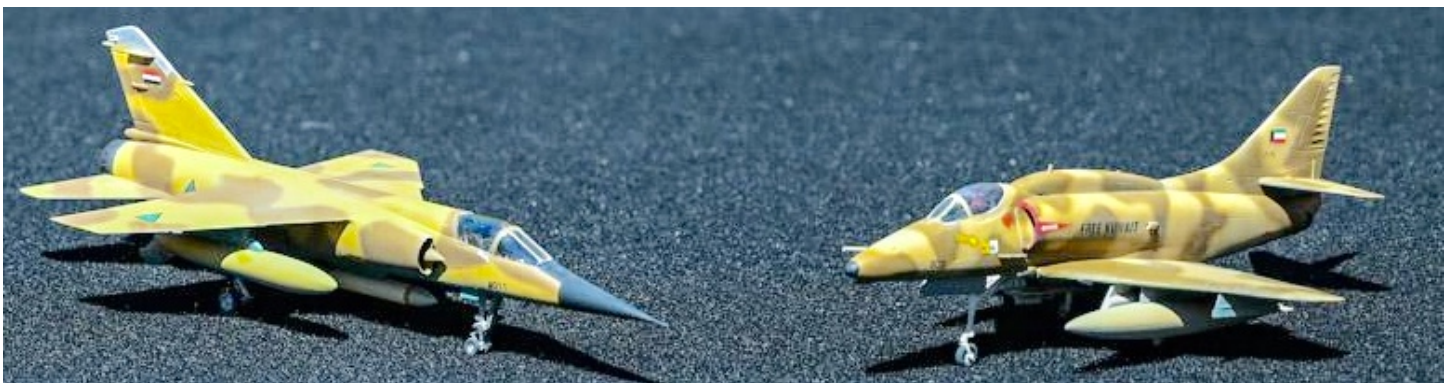

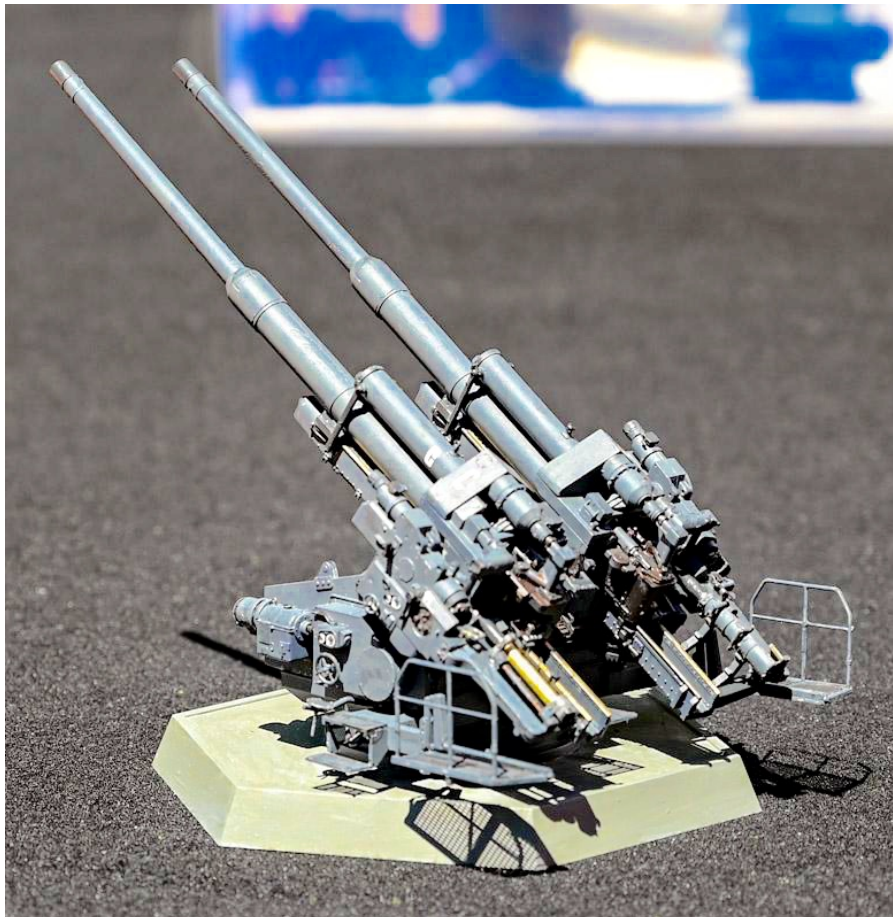

ON THE TABLES

Arthur Berdick brought 5 models to display and have photographed. These included a Tamiya Hanomag Sdkfz 251 Halftrack with Infantry, an ERTL/ESCI Nebelwefer with crew, a Takom 128mm Flak 40 Zwilling anti-aircraft gun, a Roden model of a M37 three quarter ton cargo truck. All of the above

were circa World War II. His final model was a Tamiya M 792 Gama Goat Ambulance. All models were in 1/35th scale.

Jim Davis brought a Sword model in 1/72nd scale of a TF-9J Cougar of H&MS 13, the "Outlaws." The TF-9J was the only Cougar deployed in Vietnam.

Steve Herren, our photographer bought two ships, to show, the "Pride of Baltimore II" and the "U.S.S. Constitution."

Justin Segovia had several models to show, many in vignette form. Justin bought a 1/700 scale U-boat, a 1/700 scale U -boat and a sinking ship, a 1/700th scale Soviet Typhoon class submarine, a series of Russian Hover-craft and also in 1/72nd scale a P-47N.

Dixi Fischer brought Duane Velasquez's models since Duane had to work. Duane had a Fujimi MiG 29 in Iraqi markings, a Revell Su-25 Frogfoot in Iraqi markings, a Fujimi A-4K in Kuwaiti markings, a Hasegawa A-10 with the MD tail codes and a Fujimi A-7D marked as a NM Air Guard, a Fujimi MiG 21 in Indian AF makings, a Fujimi MiG 21 in Finnish AF makings and Mirage F-1, all in 1/72nd scale.

Phoenix Villa brought two models o show, an Airfix 1/72nd scale P-51D and Tamiya 1/35th scale Motorcycle.

There were other models on the tables but were in the box, some new, others not so new.
