Efrain Zamora's AMT 1958 Plymouth Fury "Christine"




David Torres's Fine Molds 1/35th scale Type 89 Otsu Tank

David used the Vallejo IJA 1939-1945 paint set on this model. He weathered it with Tamiya Panel liner, Vallejo pigments and pastel chalks. This model represents a tank that took part in the battle of "KahlKhin Gol" in 1939 against the Soviets in Mongolia. The tank commander is a Warriors resin figure. Eventually this model will be a part of a diorama.



David Torres's Fine Molds 1/35th scale Type 94 TK

This model was painted and weathered with the same materials as on page 9. This model doesn't have the yellow out lines as not all of the Japanese tanks used them. This model will be used in a diorama as well., with a Miniart base and Finemold figures. The commander of this tank is from the MiniArt Japanese Tank Crew set.

Joe added handles to the hatches. He added headphones with cables to the Commander. The figures on the Stug III are from Panzer Art. The figure on the ground with the cats is from the Dynamo rage. The driver's hand is from his spares box. The fence and bench were from Miniart. The jug and shovel came from his spares box. Joe replaced the tow cable with one from his spares box. Joe used Lifecolor acrylic for the Panzer Grey and weathered the vehicle with oils and pastels.




