Joe Martinez's Fine Molds Type 95 Ha-Go, right face



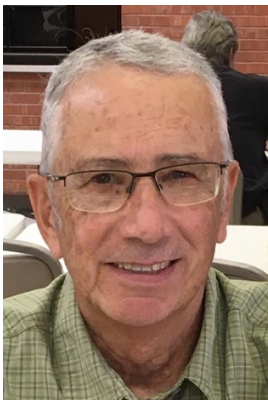
Joe Martinez's Fine Molds Type 95 Ha-Go, left face

This model represents a Type 95 of the Light Tank Company of the 1st Infantry Division based on Peleliu, circa 1944. The Company emblem and the "Izumo" inscription on the sponson were hand painted.

Joe used Fine Molds brass gun barrel, and the photo etch set. The tracks are metal and were from Friul. The spare tracks on the left rear fender were left over pieces from the track set. Joe drilled out the openings on the jack for the jack handled. The wing nuts on the tool holders and antenna base were from Model Kasten. Joe drilled out the exhaust opening. The model was painted with Vallejo and Life color acrylics and weathered with oil paint and pastel chalk.
