The hood scoop was 3D printed, as well. The motor and the headers were from two other kits. The 3D printed body and nose cone were trimmed down to fit the chassis. The water pump, wheelie bars and the parachute canister were after-market items. The decals came from 1967 Chevelle prostreet kit. My apologies to Tony for the error.

Info on Joe Martinez's Pzkpfw 38(t): Joe replaced the jack block wing nut with one from Model Kasten. He added photo chain to the towing pintle. He enhanced the Jerry can straps with Tamiya tape, and added the latch handle from his spare box, and made the hatch cover handle with brass wire. The tarps and crate are from Value Gear. For the antenna Joe stretched sprue. He used various acrylic and oil paints. The shovel came from the spare parts box, and the oil can was from Mini-Art, 1930/1940's can set.


